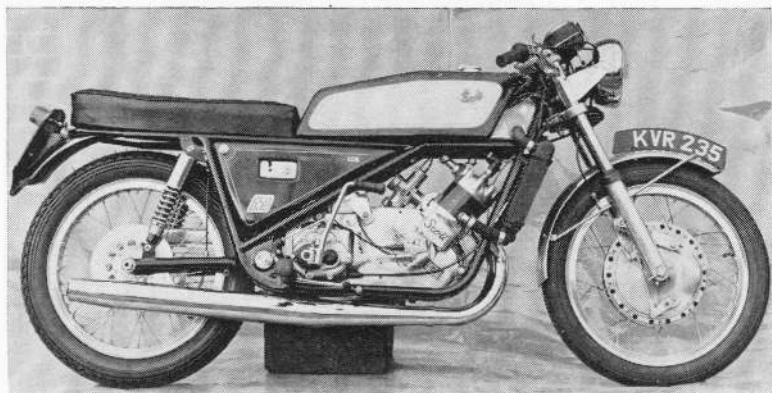


COMMENT
